**EFTSL Values**

**Advanced Diploma of Christian Ministry**

The majority of subjects are 3 hour subjects and carry 3 credit points. An annual enrolment of 24 hours of credit is considered a full-time load. Each 3 hour subject carries an EFTSL (equivalent full-time study load) value of .125%. Each Semester hour, each credit point is .04167 of an EFTSL. A full-time load of 8 such subjects (24 semester hours of credit) over the course of the academic year is considered a standard full-time load and carries an EFTSL value of 1.

**Graduate Diploma of Ministry**

The majority of subjects are 4 hour subjects and carry 4 credit points. An annual enrolment of 32 hours of credit is considered a full-time load. Each 4 hour subject carries an EFTSL (equivalent full-time study load) value of .125%. Each Semester hour, each credit point is .03125 of an EFTSL. A full-time load of 8 such subjects (32 semester hours of credit) over the course of the academic year is considered a standard full-time load and carries an EFTSL value of 1.
