## HOW DOES EXTERNAL STUDIES WORK?

Studying externally at PBC is designed to provide you with a learning experience which is not dissimilar from those attending on-campus. This is achieved by providing you with video and/or audio recordings, reading resources, an online learning environment and easily accessible lecturers and student support services. Like an on-campus student, you will need to complete a range of different assessment tasks which demonstrate your progress in the units and provide you with an opportunity to receive feedback on your learning.

## WHAT DO I NEED?

You will need to have access to the internet to enable you to access all learning resources and learning environments. You will also need to ensure that you have enough time within your schedule to allow you to complete units. A rough guide is that you will need around 8 hours per week per unit across the 18 weeks that make up a semester, but the beauty of external studies is that you can plan exactly how you complete these time commitments.
